PURPOSE:

The purpose of the Viewmont Alumni Association Scholarship is to recognize graduating seniors of Viewmont High School for their community service, citizenship and scholarship and to aid them financially in pursuing post secondary education. Community service entails reaching out to less fortunate members of the community at large in sharing an individual's resources, time, talents, and knowledge. Good citizenship encourages a student's positive relationships with other diverse members of the school and community by supporting laws and equal opportunities for all. Scholarship is the natural extension of life long learning.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

1. Must be a graduating senior of Viewmont High School.
2. Must have met citizenship requirements (which means no unsatisfied demerits) of Viewmont at the time of the award.
3. Must use the funds within twelve (12) months of award for post high school education at an accredited community college, trade school or institution of higher learning (unless there is an approved exemption for missionary, military or other service).
4. The applicant must be of good moral character and integrity and not have been charged with alcohol, drug abuse or violent behavior during the preceding three (3) years in high school.
5. Must submit an application and an essay explaining qualifications, community service to others, citizenship and identifying the college or school to be attended.
6. May be nominated by a faculty or staff member who is not related to the applicant.
7. Must have demonstrated community service, scholarship and citizenship to fellow students.
8. One or more of applicant's parents attended Viewmont.
9. The applicant will have demonstrated leadership at Viewmont.
10. The award recipient will not be receiving other scholarship funds or that the amount of all other scholarships does not exceed the actual cost of the education, tuition, fees and books.
11. A copy of the applicant's high school transcripts shall be included with the application.
12. Must include written recommendations from two (2) teachers at Viewmont and one (1) recommendation from a peer at Viewmont.
13. Application filing deadline is April 30th of each school year. File at VHS counseling office.

I understand and agree that no other scholarship funds from any source may be received that will exceed the total amount of tuition and fees for the applicable school in the year the Alumni Scholarship will be utilized.
